In addition to classroom instruction on workplace readiness skills, instruction is also provided to ensure student safety in the work environment. CWE safety lessons are designed to prepare students for safe and successful participation in the areas of:

- Preparing for Work – Self-Advocacy and Job Safety
- Getting to Work – Travel Safety for the CWE
- Building Relationships at Work – Identification of Bullying and Harassment\*

Students will:

- Define professional relationships
  - Demonstrate increased understanding of harassment, including sexual, gender, disability, religion, race, and national origin
  - Define types of harassment (verbal, physical, written, and electronic) and the importance of reporting
  - Explain that there are laws protecting them from harassment
- Solving Problems at Work – Job Hazards and Emergencies
